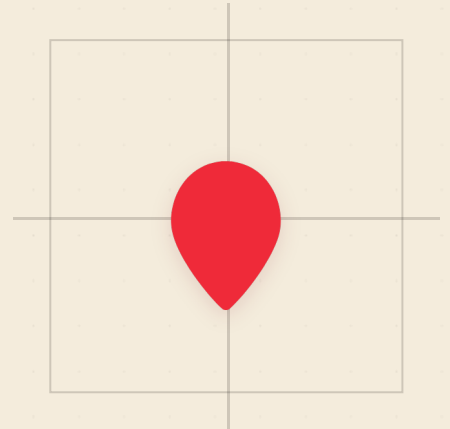


A QUIET MOVEMENT WORTH SPREADING

THE PROBLEM

We were tired of watching good food and good money *leave the building.*

The rider who never comes. The order seen-zoned in a group chat. The lola who could feed the whole floor but has nowhere to sell. A third of every peso handed to an app that was never from here. So we built the opposite: a market that belongs to the people who live in it.

WALANG RIDER

Forty-five minutes for five floors, if they come at all.

SEEN-ZONED

Good orders lost under "good morning" stickers by lunch.

MAY KALTAS

Up to a third of a cook's income, gone to an app.

FAST FOOD

Cheaper to order chips than to buy real lutong bahay.

THE VISION & THE GOALS

Bawat building, *sariling palengke.*

A country where every building feeds itself. Where a lola's cooking pays her bills. Where the money you spend on merienda stays three floors away, with a neighbor, instead of leaving for an app. Not a delivery giant. A thousand small markets, each one owned by the people who live there.

EVERY BUILDING

One market for every condo, village, and barangay.

ZERO COMMISSION

Cooks keep one hundred percent, forever.

NEIGHBORS FIRST

Handed over by the person down the hall.

BAGONG BAYANIHAN

Every order is a neighbor earning. That is the point.

EXPLAIN IT IN ONE BREATH.

Suki is a marketplace locked to your building. Neighbors sell home-cooked food to neighbors, get paid directly with zero commission, and the app always knows what is still available. That is the whole thing.

"It is like a food-delivery app that only works inside your own building. Run by your neighbors, cooked by your neighbors, with no commission taken from anyone."

SAY IT LIKE THIS

COMMUNITY- LOCKED

One building, one market. You order only where you belong.

PAID DIRECT

GCash, cash, or bank. The cook keeps everything.

ALWAYS FRESH

Listings expire in 12 hours, so "meron pa po ba" is answered.

BAYANIHAN

Every order is a neighbor earning a living at home.

You do not need to build anything. You just need to point the right person to Suki.
Four ways, and the exact words to use.

01

Tell a group admin

The person who runs your condo or village chat can start a market in two minutes.

SAY THIS: "YOU ALREADY RUN THE GROUP. YOU COULD RUN THE MARKET. SUKINEIGHBORS.COM."

02

Tell a home cook

Someone you know cooks better than half the carinderias and has nowhere to sell.

SAY THIS: "SELL IT TO THE BUILDING. WALANG COMMISSION, BAYAD DIREKTA. POST ONE BENTA."

03

Share the mission

Post it once to your following. The idea travels on its own.

SAY THIS: "NEIGHBORS FEEDING NEIGHBORS, ZERO COMMISSION. BAWAT BUILDING, SARILING PALENGKE."

04

Bring your own building

Start it where you live and pull the first few cooks in yourself.

SAY THIS: "TARA, GAWIN NATIN DITO. AKO NA ANG MAG-UUMPISA."

THE RIPPLE

A single introduction can start a market. One market can carry a dozen kitchens. A dozen kitchens can feed a whole building and put income back in a dozen homes. That is how this grows: *one neighbor telling another.*
